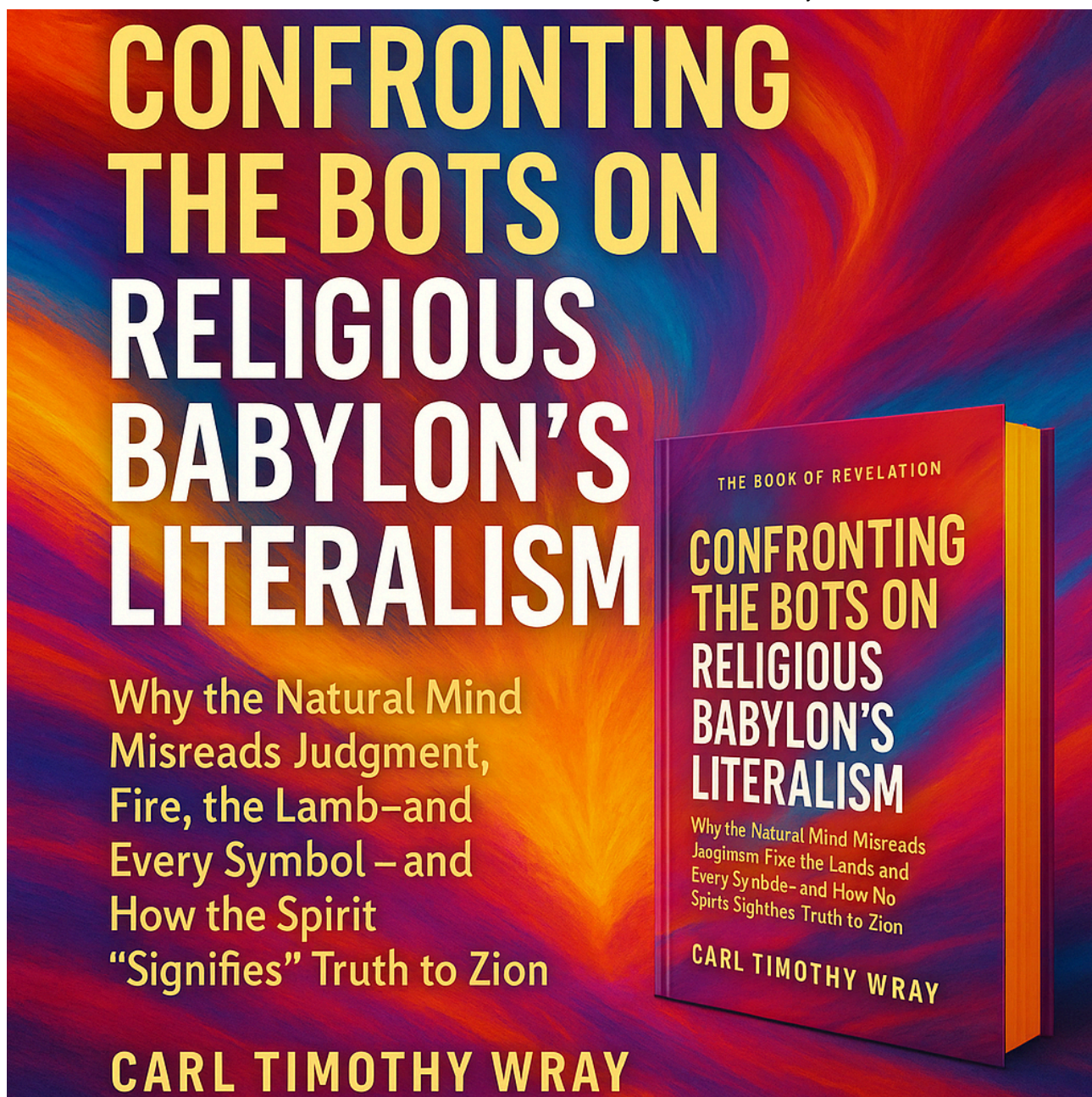

separation between judgment and mercy

separation between fire and love

separation between the Lamb and His sons

Zion is union.

Babylon is division.

So Babylon produces fear.  
Zion produces revelation.
