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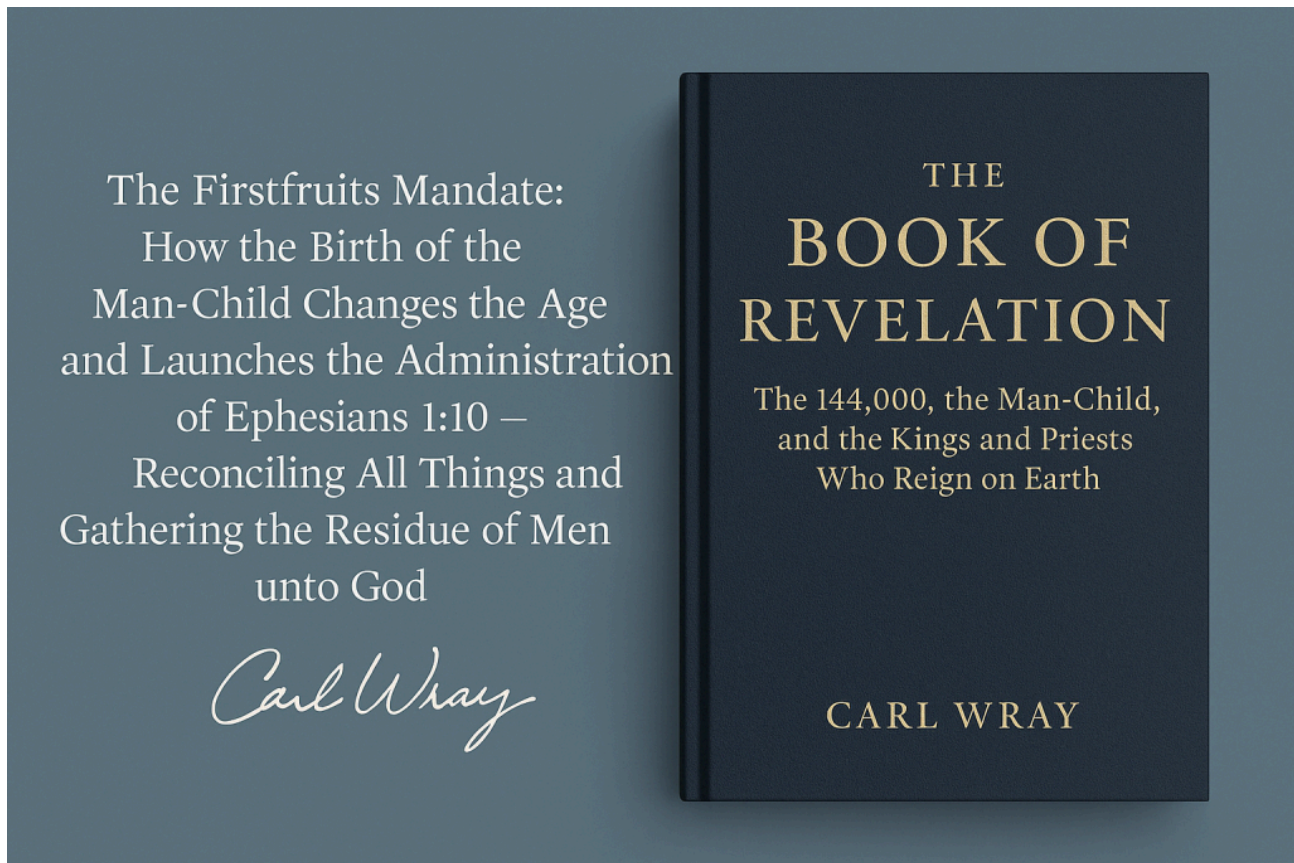

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◆ Introduction

In this Kingdom, the will of God is not enforced but embraced. Every creature, seeing His image unveiled, awakens to its true identity. This is the Lamb's way — transforming enemies into sons by revelation, not coercion. It is written, "They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, for the earth

shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord.” (Isaiah 11 : 9)

Amen.

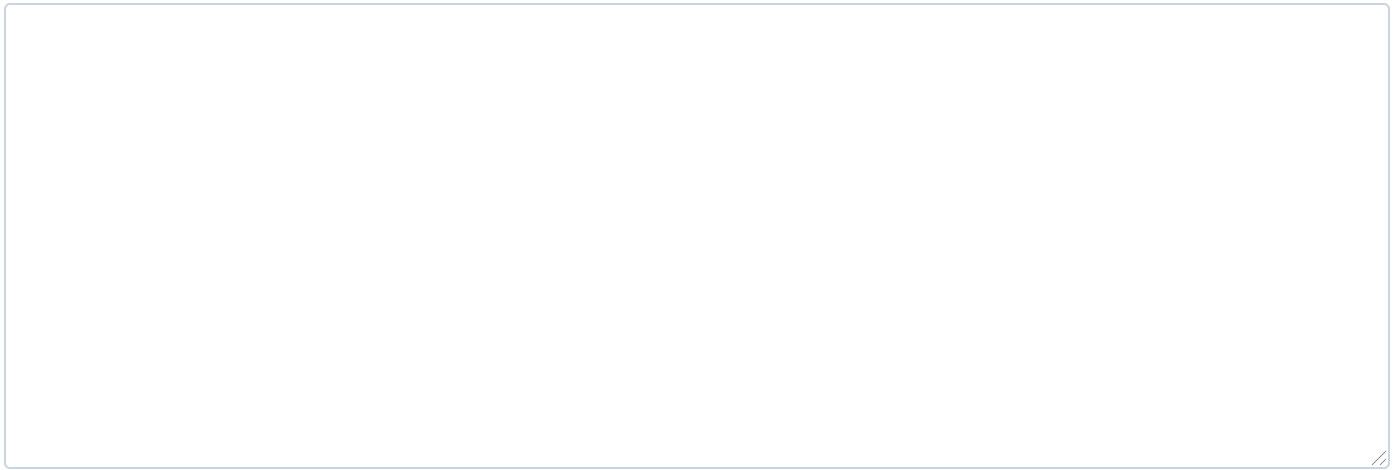
