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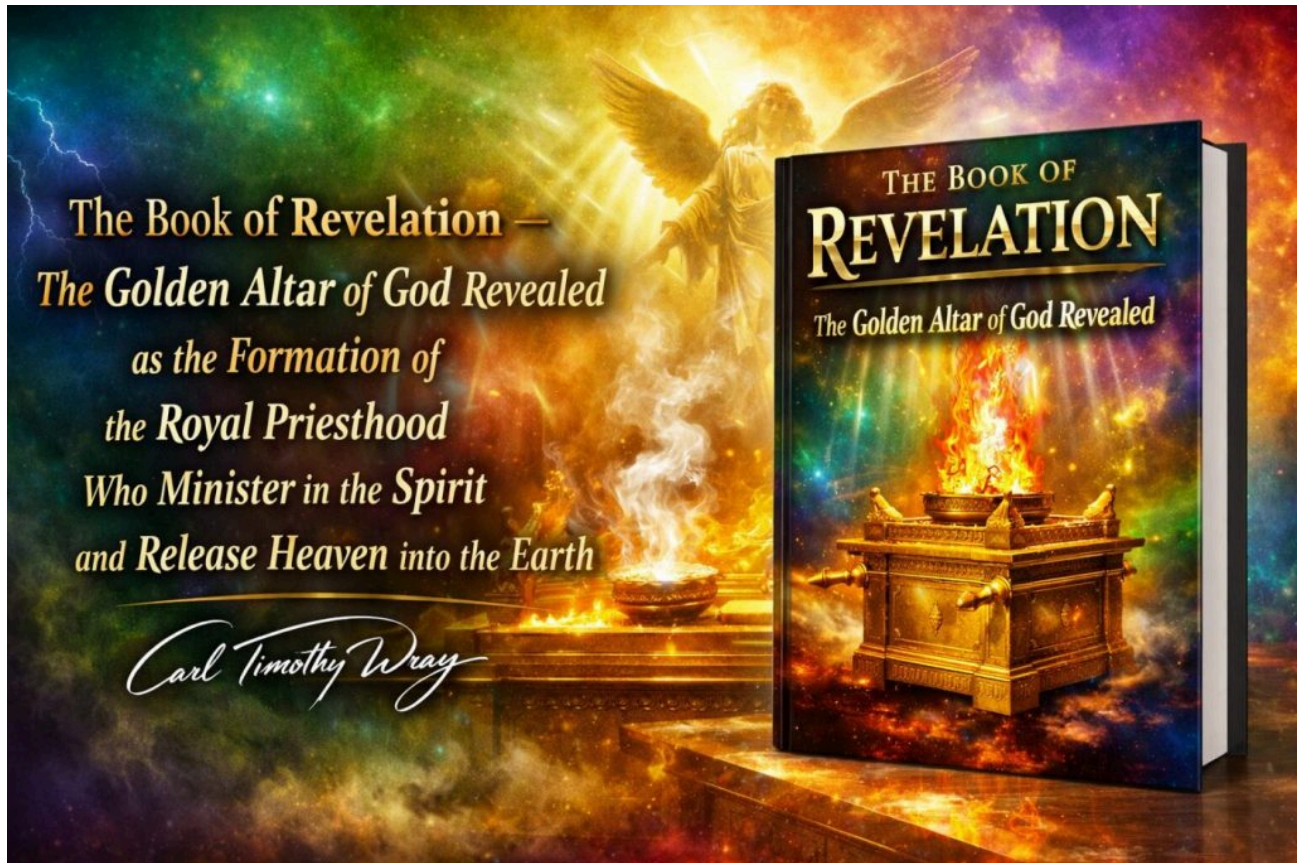

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## The One Standing at the Altar

## The Angel Is Christ in Priestly Function

Now we return to Revelation:

# The Censer in the Hand of the Priest

## What Is a Censer?
