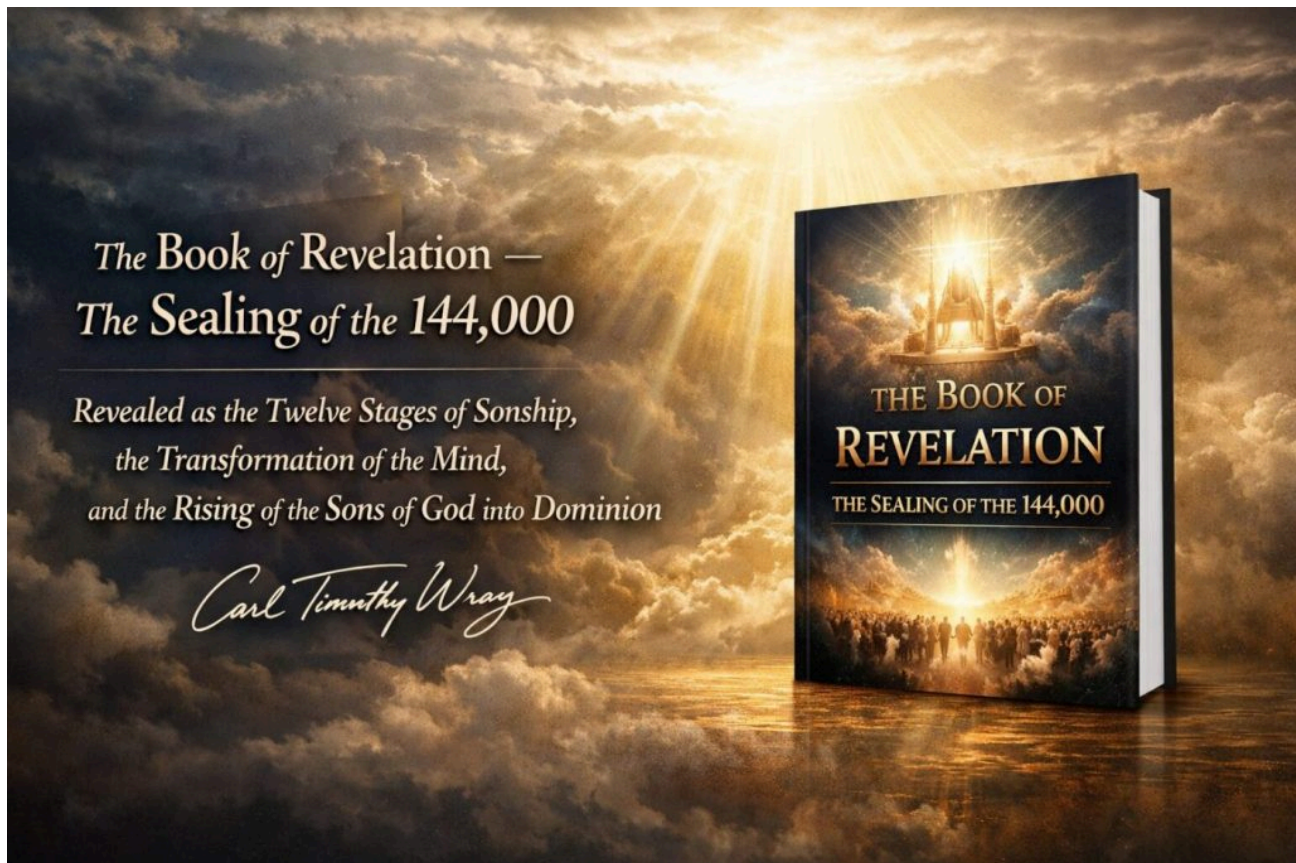

# CHAPTER 1 — THE BOOK OF REVELATION IS A SPIRITUAL BOOK

*“The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto Him... and He sent and signified it...”* — Revelation 1:1

The word **“signified”** means to communicate by signs, symbols, and spiritual language. This is not a natural book — it is a **spiritual unveiling**.

If the book is signified, then it cannot be correctly understood through literal interpretation. It must be discerned by the Spirit.

This is why the apostle Paul wrote:

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# God Has Always Spoken Through Signs and Similitudes
