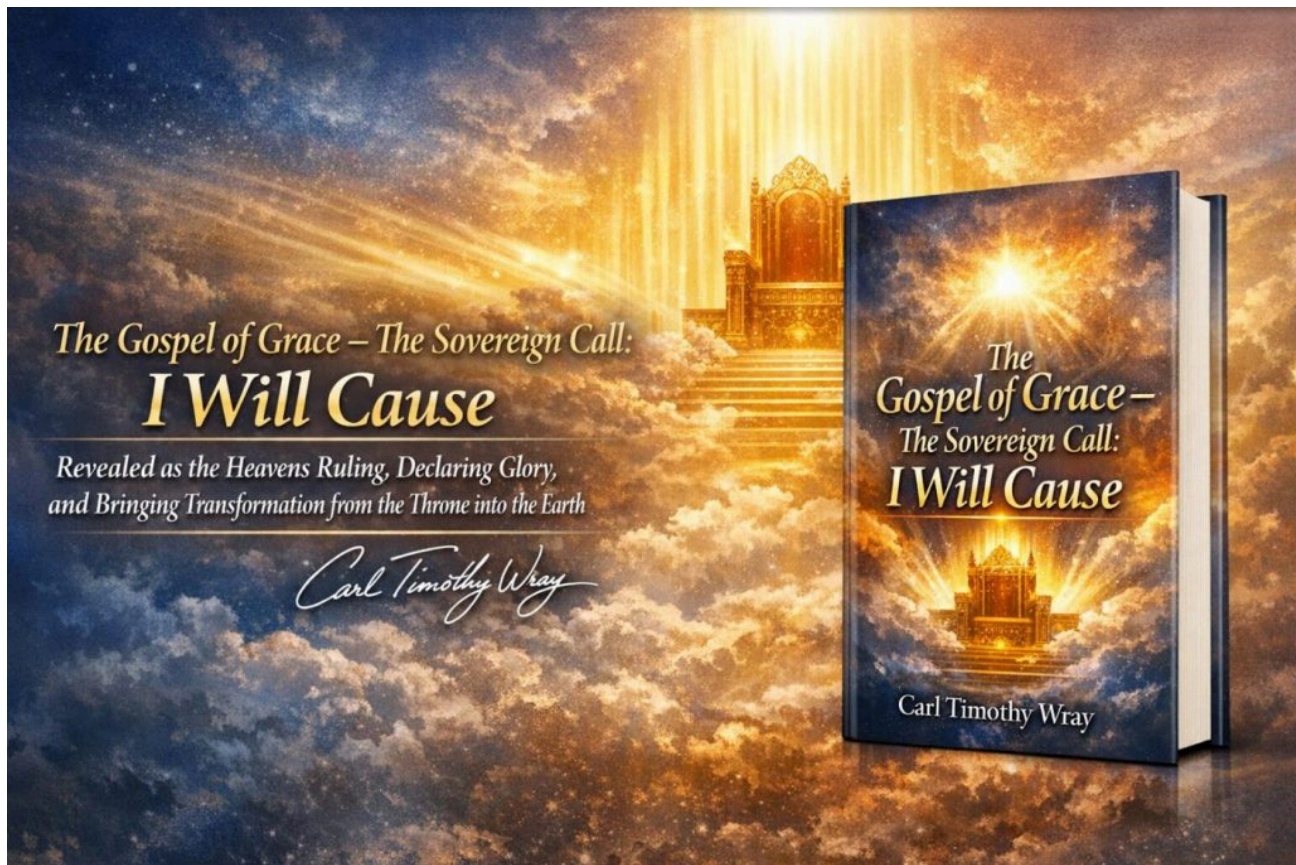

The mind of the Spirit interprets life through:

- The Word of God
- The finished work of Christ

☞ What you focus on determines what you experience.

---

## 🔥 Seeing What Heaven Has Already Declared

When your mind is set above, you begin to see:

- What God has already finished
- What the throne has already established
- What the Word has already spoken

“While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen...” — 2 Corinthians 4:18
