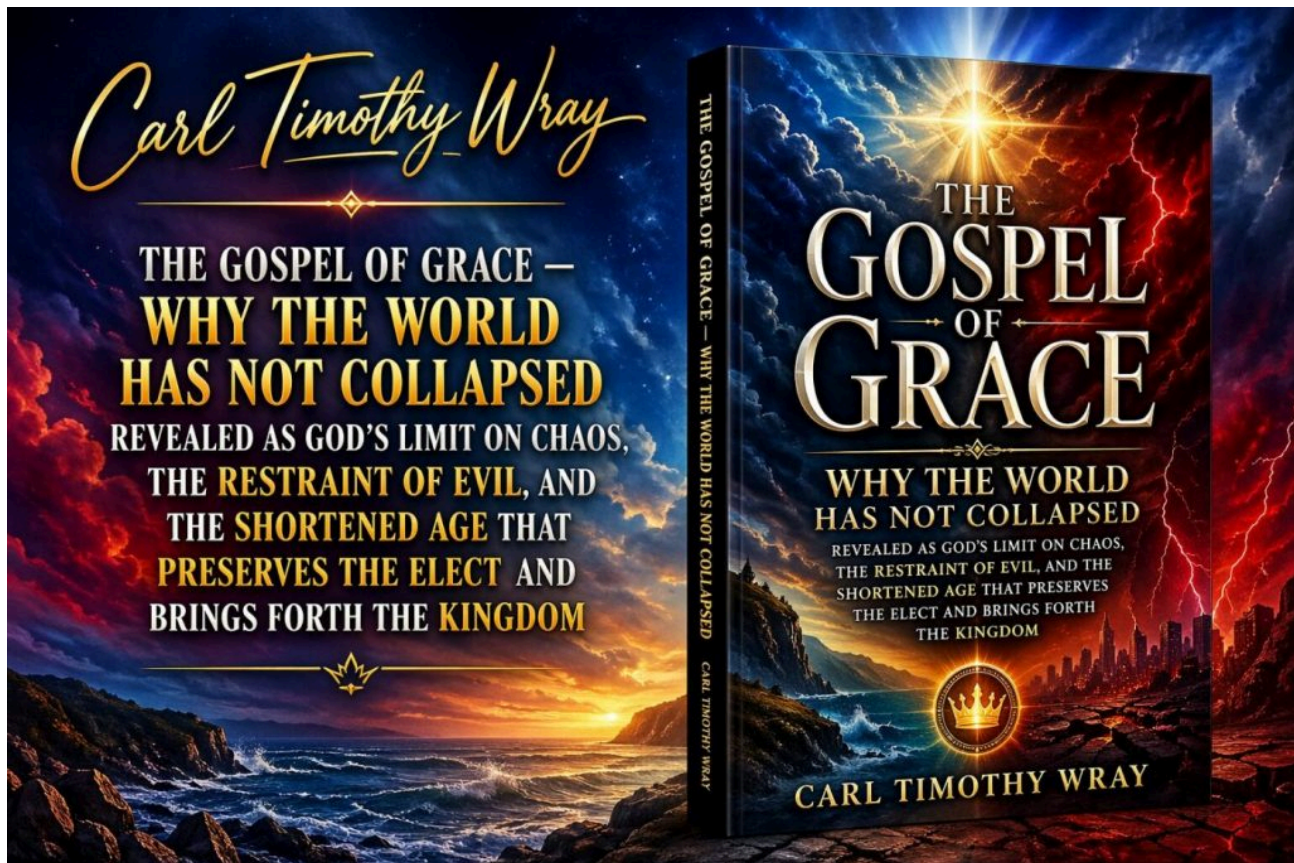

Continue into the next chapter and uncover why, even now, chaos has not overtaken the earth—and what is actively restraining it from doing so.

Where Christ is revealed, chaos must stop.

CHAPTER 7 — THE SUSTAINING POWER: WHY EVERYTHING IS STILL HOLDING TOGETHER

THE WORLD IS NOT STABLE — IT IS BEING SUSTAINED

Look honestly at the condition of the world:

- Systems are fragile

👉 Mixture.
