The Revelation of Jesus Christ:

Introduction

Revelation

Romans 8:23 says we possess the firstfruits of the Spirit and groan for the redemption of our body. That groaning is the sound of creation's womb; the pressure of transformation within this present evil age until mortality is swallowed up of life. The Firstfruit law demands that what appeared in one must appear in many. The same incorruptible life that raised Christ from the grave must quicken His body on earth.

Declaration

The law of the Firstfruits cannot fail. The Seed that conquered death is reproducing after His kind. A company is rising who will manifest the life of Christ openly, proving that death has lost dominion. This is the fulfillment of the Feast of Tabernacles—the habitation of God in immortal flesh. The Firstfruits are the sign that the harvest of the Kingdom has begun.

Call to Action

Beloved, recognize the Seed within you. Honor the law of the Firstfruits by yielding your whole field to the Spirit's cultivation. Let the incorruptible life mature from seed to blade, from ear to full ear, until the Firstfruits ministry is revealed in you. The harvest waits for no delay; the Lord of the harvest is walking through His garden. The age of death is closing; the manifestation of immortality is breaking forth. All divine increase flows from *The Revelation of Jesus Christ*, where the seed of His life governs every harvest of the Spirit.

Chapter 2 The Seed in Genesis

Definition

The story of firstfruits begins in Genesis, where God spoke: "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself." (Genesis 1:11–12). This simple phrase hides an eternal law—the seed carries within it the pattern of its own fullness. Whatever is planted must reproduce its image. When Adam fell, the divine seed lay dormant in the soil of humanity, waiting for the promised Seed who would bruise the serpent's head (Genesis 3:15). Revelation

Hosea spoke of Israel as grapes found in the wilderness (Hosea 9:10). Joel promised that the floors would be full of wheat and the vats would overflow with new wine and oil (Joel 2:24). These were not just agricultural blessings—they were signs pointing forward to a spiritual harvest. The prophets saw a people chosen first, set apart to reveal God's nature to the nations.

Revelation

When the Spirit opens the Revelation of Jesus Christ within the prophets, their words become windows into the eternal purpose. Israel's call as the firstfruits nation was a shadow of a greater company—the sons and daughters who would bear the life of Christ within this present evil age. The prophets saw beyond their time: a remnant refined by fire, purified as gold, prepared to manifest the glory of God in human form.

Joel's prophecy of the early and latter rain unfolds as the law of the harvest itself—seed, blade, ear, and full ear. The early rain germinates the seed; the latter rain brings the fruit to maturity. So too, the Spirit that came at Pentecost began the growth of the church, and the same Spirit in latter-rain fullness will ripen the Firstfruits Company into immortality. Isaiah glimpsed this when he said, "Your dead shall live; together with my dead body they shall arise." (Isaiah 26:19). He saw the shadow of resurrection life breaking the power of death.

Declaration

Chapter 4 Christ the Firstfruit

Definition

Paul declared, "But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept. For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead." (1 Corinthians 15:20-21). In Him, the old harvest of Adam ended, and the new creation began. When Jesus stepped out of the tomb, He became the Firstfruit of an immortal order—the living proof that the law of sin and death had been broken. Revelation

In the Revelation of Jesus Christ, the resurrection is not merely history; it is the law of life being unveiled. Revelation

"And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on Mount Zion, and with Him an hundred forty and four thousand, having His Father's name written in their foreheads ... These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb." (Revelation 14:1–4)

This vision describes the manifestation of the Firstfruits—a company of redeemed ones who mirror the Lamb. They stand with Him, not beneath Him, because His life

has become their life. They are undefiled by the spirit of this age, following the Lamb wherever He goes. The Father's name written in their foreheads signifies a renewed mind— the mind of Christ fully formed in them. This is the point where the harvest begins to shine in the noonday of revelation.

Revelation

Definition
